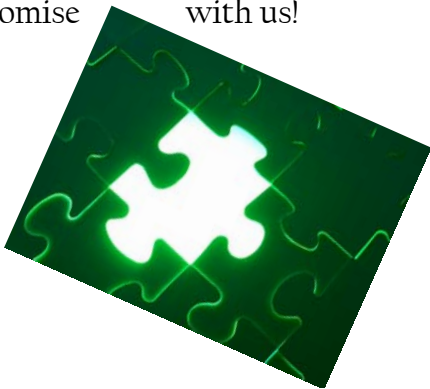


Welcome

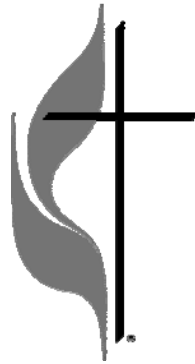
